Answers to common questions like this young woman's MUST be grounded in Scripture, not in our ancient traditions, our modern opinions, or our personal desires for "rights." Her questions reveal the heart cry of cultures around the world, and they should challenge all of us as Christians to explore the Bible in its entirety to understand God's desire for the male/female relationship.

Serving Shoulder to Shoulder seeks to do just that – provide a God-honoring response through sound biblical study that displays God's intent and purpose of creating man and woman – together.

THE S2S SERVANT

What exactly is an S2S Servant?

S2S Servants are those men and women who passionately **love Jesus** and **honor His Word** by diligently studying and obeying Scripture. They are **committed to God's mission** – the message of repentance, forgiveness, and full life offered through Christ for all nations. They passionately pursue extending God's kingdom to those **nearby** and to the **ends of the earth.** They believe both men and women are created in the image of God and this shared image-bearing responsibility propels them both to love well and to lead well. They seek to live a kingdom ethic of leadership – marked by a **passion to serve** rather than a fight for position or authority. Their **unity serves as a weapon** as they display the scriptural "one another" principles.

They esteem, promote, and build up the other and honor the Holy Spirit who blesses Jesus' Bride with every spiritual gift to build the Church and reach the world. Even when attacked, S2S servants sacrificially take in their flesh the sufferings of Christ who was accused, insulted, mocked, and condemned. In return, they pray for those who attack them, seeking to live with "purified lips" that honor the Lord Jesus and the Church as the Bride of Christ. S2S servants are marked by humility, integrity, teachability, godliness, and urgency for the Gospel. They remove hurdles of sinful tradition so that they and others can run fast, run far, and run together to complete the Great Commission.

Together unified, they are on the move.



THE FIVE FAMILIES



Running fast and far together to complete the Great Commission requires relating with other people (not surprising!). Across the timeline of humanity, large general periods indicate how men and women relate with one another (and with God). We call these five general periods "families."

Understanding the Five Families gives us a clear picture of God's heart and intent, as well as people's sin and need. The first family (Ideal) and the last family (Forever) demonstrate the bookends of God's perfect plan for people at creation and into eternity future. The central (Redeemed) family focuses on the cross of Christ as the pivotal centerpiece of all history. These "up" times are shining pinnacles of God's design and holiness. These mountaintops serve as the goals, the guides, the standards to keep in mind. The second (Fallen) and fourth (Multiplied) families reveal the struggle with the sin of our cultures and our need to complete Jesus' commission. These "down" times show the valleys where men and women labor to overcome evil, deceit, and doubt.

As you seek to run with Jesus, even as we live in the present valley of sin and death, let us fix our eyes on God's original intent, his glorious sacrifice, and life in his eternal presence.


You are BLESSED to BE a BLESSING!




KEEP THE **FOREVER** FAMILY IN SIGHT.




